AN ABRAHAMIC COVENANT OVERVIEW

God's relationship to Israel is based on the Abrahamic Covenant - Genesis 12:1-3, 15:1-18

The Covenant establishes a unique bond between Israel and God

The Covenant promises God's protection for the Jewish people. Gen. 12:1-3,

The Covenant grants the Land of Israel to the Hebrews, the people of Israel. Gen. 15:18-21, 17:8

The Covenant line goes through Isaac & Jacob, not Ishmael and Esau. 1st Chron 16:15-17, Ps 105:8

The Covenant remains in effect even though the Mosaic Covenant has been broken. Gal. 3:15-18

The Covenant is the "Legal basis" for the sending of Messiah Yeshua. Luke 1:67-73

While the Covenant anticipates an ultimate National salvation of Israel, each individual Jewish
person, like every human being, is still a sinner in need of a redeemer. Isa. 59:1-2, 16, 20
